

# What Services May Be Available for Human Trafficking or Sexual Assault Survivors?

## Advocacy

Advocates work to address the concerns and needs of victims. Services typically offered by advocates include

- Legal Support and Accompaniment
- Medical Advocacy and Accompaniment
- Emotional Support
- Help finding other resources, services and aid

## Shelters

Shelters offer a safe place for victims/survivors to stay! Many shelters will work with victims to create a safety plan to stay safe and reduce future harm!

## Counseling Services

Counseling services are available to victims and survivors- regardless of when it happened! These trauma-informed sessions and support groups may even be free of cost to the victim depending on the organization!
